

COVID-19 SAFETY POLICY FOR MMA EVENTS

Purpose

In response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, MMA has adopted the following policy (“Policy”) to safeguard the health and well-being of individuals attending MMA events (“Event(s)”) and the communities in which Events are held. This Policy is intended to comply with applicable laws and regulations and is based upon guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) and public health authorities, as applicable.

Scope

As a condition of attendance at Events, all attendees must:

1. be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by the first date of the Event. For purposes of this Policy, “fully vaccinated” means two weeks after having received a second dose in a two-dose series, or two weeks after the single-dose J&J/Janssen vaccine. Fully vaccinated, however, is not the same as having the best protection. The MMA strongly encourages all attendees to maximize their protection by being up to date on their protection, which includes getting boosters when eligible;
2. agree not to attend Events if symptomatic; and
3. agree to notify MMA of a positive COVID-19 test result within 14 days of the Event so other attendees can be notified of a possible exposure.

Policy

Individuals seeking to attend Events must submit an ATTESTATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH COVID-19 SAFETY POLICY at the time of registration for each Event. Individuals must also submit an ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY FORM and adhere to all safety and health protocols issued by MMA or any federal, state, or local authorities in place at the time of the Event. If requested by MMA, individuals seeking to attend Event(s) shall submit documentation and proof to support their vaccination status.

Consequences of Non-Compliance

Individuals who do not comply with this Policy will be denied participation in MMA Event(s) and may be removed from Event(s) without refund of any registration fees.

Right To Change or Terminate This Policy

MMA may change, suspend, or revoke all or part of this Policy at any time, at its sole discretion, without prior notice.
